BOARDING STUDENTS (5-day boarders may decrease as necessary)

- Seasonal items such as winter gloves and a warm hat do not necessarily have to be brought to school in the early fall. Most will need to arrive after the fall long weekend or Thanksgiving. Use your discretion as to what clothing items your son will need given for the season.
 - It is recommended that 7-day boarding students come with some sort of footlocker (regular or smaller size with a combination lock) for the dorm to keep valued items in. Oversized lockers take up too much space.
 - Boarders may bring appropriate posters, pictures, please refer to the technology policy and student handbook when deciding which electronics your son will bring. 5-day boarders will not need more than an Ipod.
- **Please mark all belongings, including clothes, with your son's name. This is very important in preventing loss of items.**
